



## Here are the steps to follow to claim your PDUs:

1. You must log into your global PMI account: <https://www.pmi.org/>
2. Go to the "myPMI" tab, then "Report PDUs on CCRS" and "Report PDUs" in the left column.

You should be able to see this:



3. Click on "Online or Digital Media"

**Provider:** CO19 (for PMI-Montreal)

**Title:** Copy / paste from the webinar (on the website [www.pmimontreal.org](http://www.pmimontreal.org))


**Description:** Copy / pasted of the conference description

**URL:** optional


**Date Started:** Date you started viewing

**Date Completed:** Date on which you finished viewing

**Claimed PDUs:** Enter the number of PDUs and the type of PDUs that the event allows you to claim (usually found in the description of the event).
